ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- The Artist may submit two (2) framed paintings for judging. Paintings mounted on canvas, cradle board, or float frame, and varnished with a transparent coating are also acceptable.
- The Artist may submit two (2) additional matted and clear wrapped paintings for sale, size half sheet or less.

ELIGIBILITY

- SWWS 2022 paid juried members
- Watercolor or water media paintings done in the last two years, not shown with SWWS
- Must be original work of the artist.
- No copies of other artist's or photographer's work are acceptable.
- Nudes must be pre-approved at time of entry by an SWWS committee.
- SWWS reserves the right to refuse a painting not meeting the Prospectus.

FRAMING REQUIREMENTS for JUDGED ART

- Framed work should be covered by Plexiglas or acrylic. **Glass is not permitted.**
- Neutral frames less than two inches wide, with white or off-white mat, are allowed.
- Maximum size is 36 x 42 inches and 20 lbs.
- Triptych and diptych must conform to size.
- A mat with a ½ inch colored liner is OK.
- Judged paintings must be ready to hang with D-ring style hangers, and taut, plastic coated picture wire.
- Unacceptable are screw eye or saw tooth hangers, clips, or uncoated metal wire.

Artists: attach identification with your name, title, and media to the back side of each artwork.

PAINTING REQUIREMENTS

- Paintings must be on an acid-free surface.
- Printed and computer-generated material is not acceptable.
- Collage material must be original water media on paper and executed by the artist.
- Those handling the show will be careful, yet SWWS will not assume responsibility for loss or damage to paintings.
- By entering the show, the artist gives SWWS the right to use printed and electronic images of the paintings for SWWS promotional and educational purposes, including the SWWS website, brochures, and press.
- *Please* take photos before each painting is framed, for use by SWWS on their website. We may ask for some of them later.

SALES

- SWWS will collect a 10% commission on all sales. We will collect taxes from buyer.
- SWWS will write checks to artists for sales within 30 days.
- Credit card sales go through SWWS.
- Paintings remain on display until the close of show, unless sold.
- Artists: Keep a copy of your registration because the price listed must match tag.
